

Kagan Strategies

Stand Up, Hand Up, Pair Up

- Teacher presents a problem or a question to students
- Teacher asks each students to solve/write down their answer independently
- Teacher then asks students to stand up and put one hand up
- Teacher tells students to high five each other when they find a partner
- Partners share answers with each other

Numbered Heads Together

- Number students 1-4 in each group
- Teacher presents a problem
- All students work independently on the problem, and stand up when finished
When all group members are standing, they share their answers
- When they are done sharing and have come to a consensus , they all sit down
- Teacher calls one number (1-4) to share out to whole class

Pairs Check

- Teacher has class set up in groups of 4 (2 pairs of 2)
- Partner A works the first problem as Partner B coaches if needed
- Partner B works the next problem and Partner A coaches if needed
- After the sheet is finished Pairs compare
