



WHAT DOES A LEARNING TARGET LOOK LIKE IN A SAN YSIDRO HIGH SCHOOL CLASSROOM?

1. The L.T. is posted in a strategic location in the classroom and the student's know where to find it for their class or lesson
2. The L.T. addresses the guidelines that include a :
 - time frame
 - verb
 - content/concept/skill
 - activity
 - assessment/product
3. There is a consistent manner by all teachers to assess student learning of L.T.
Some examples:
 - Exit Slip
 - Quick write
 - Process can be explained
 - Vocabulary defined
4. The L.T. is based on and addresses grade level standards
5. Student activities and engagement are aligned to the L.T.
6. Teachers use a variety of strategies to communicate the L.T. to all students
7. Teachers refer to the L.T. throughout the lesson to enable students to recall the purpose of the learning
8. Teachers connect long term learning goal to the daily L.T.
9. Students are given opportunities throughout the lesson to reflect and discuss the L.T.
10. Prior learning is activated by the use of the L.T.
